The NFHS reviewed your new product – the 2014 Unequal Technologies GYRO Supplemental Head Padding for football. It was submitted to the NFHS from your company to make sure it complies with current 2014 NFHS Football Rules.

As the liaison to the NFHS Football Rules Committee, who is charged with giving responses to manufacturers' request about equipment, I am writing to advise you that the leadership of the Committee has concluded that your 2014 Unequal Technologies GYRO Supplemental Head Padding for football does comply with current NFHS Football Rule 1-5-1.

Currently, the NFHS Football Rules Committee does not have any proposals from member state high school associations to change the above mentioned rules.

You would need to contact the NCAA to see what their interpretation is for the college level.
